

CenterStage Performing Arts Academy Scholarships 2019-2020

Available:

THREE New To CS Scholarship: \$30 per month for the 2019 – 2020 dance year*

THREE Bronze Scholarship: \$40 per month for the 2019-2020 dance year*

THREE Silver Scholarship: \$75 per month for the 2019-2020 dance year*

THREE Gold Scholarship: \$100 per month for the 2019-2020 dance year *

ONE Private Lesson Scholarship \$75 per month for the 2019 – 2020 dance year*

*all scholarships recipients will be reviewed after the 2019 fall semester to ensure that they are meeting the requirements of their award. Scholarship funds will not be distributed for the spring semester if any of the requirements are not upheld. Any surrendered scholarships will be awarded to an alternate student via the Gallatin Arts Council.

Eligibility for the New To CS Scholarship

1. Must be enrolled in 2 or more classes for the 2019-2020 dance year.
2. Must pay all tuition payments on time for the 2019-2020 dance year. **No exceptions.**
3. Must submit a one-page essay explaining their need for financial aid, why they love to dance, and what their goals are for the 2019-2020 year.
4. **Must have turned in a completed application (essay and proof of enrollment) by the established deadline: August 1, 2019. No exceptions.**

Eligibility for the Bronze, Silver, and Gold Scholarship

1. For the Gold, Silver, and Bronze scholarships, the student must have danced in at least one CenterStage dance class for the duration of the 2018-2019 dance year (August – June recital).
2. Must submit a record of excellent attendance from the 2018-2019 dance year. Attendance records can be obtained by emailing info@performcenterstage.com.
3. Must be enrolled in 3 or more classes for the 2019-2020 dance year if applying for Bronze, 4 or more classes if applying for Silver, and 5 or more if applying for Gold.
4. Must pay all tuition payments on time for the 2019-2020 dance year. **No exceptions.**
5. Must submit a one-page essay explaining their need for financial aid, why they love to dance, and what their goals are for the 2019-2020 year.
6. Must receive 2 or more acclamations from CenterStage instructors for being respectful in class, and showing dedication to their craft. Students should reach out to instructors before their application is submitted. **Cannot be Studio Director.**
7. **Must have turned in a completed application by the established deadline: August 1, 2019. No exceptions.**
8. **Suggested Youtube link of dance performance reel. *Suggested but not required.**
9. **Applications lacking a record of attendance, proof of enrollment, essay, and/or two acclamations will not be considered.**

Eligibility for Private Lesson Scholarship:

1. Must submit a YouTube performance reel of instrument or vocal performance.

2. Must participate or help produce SpringBoard productions: On Broadway, Deck the Halls, and Pop Show.
3. Must pay all tuition payments on time for the 2019-2020 dance year. **No exceptions.**
4. Must submit a one-page essay explaining their need for financial aid, why they love to dance, and what their goals are for the 2019-2020 year.
5. **Must have turned in a completed application (essay and proof of enrollment) by the established deadline: August 1, 2019. No exceptions.**
